






Ayutthaya's Social Security Insurers





Revenue Structure under Social Security Scheme











Revenue Breakdown By Patient Type







Revenue from Hospital Operations (THB Million)






OPD - Non SW Patients


OPD Utilization Rate – All Sectors


IPD – Non SW Patients

Income from Accident Cases & Cathlab Cases






IPD Utilization Rate – All Sectors


IPD Capacity (Beds) ^{/1} & Utilization Rate (%) ^{/2}








Non-SW Revenue excluded Covid-19 Test








Social Security Revenue




